THE WHY: ALIGNMENT BEFORE ACCELERATION

Before God accelerates His people, He aligns them. Throughout Scripture, momentum follows unity. God does not rush ahead of a divided people, but He moves powerfully through a people who are ordered, attentive, and walking together in obedience.

"All the believers were together and had everything in common."

– Acts 2:44

In the early church, spiritual power flowed from shared devotion and shared responsibility. Alignment was not uniformity, but a common direction. Not everyone carried the same role, but everyone carried the same vision.

3-2 and DONE is a 12-month housewide journey, of alignment, sacrifice, and vision, beginning in January 2026 - December 31st 2026,. It is an intentional season of moving together prayerfully, faithfully, and with clarity of purpose. When the house moves together, the mission moves forward. And when the mission moves forward, acceleration follows, not by striving, but by God's grace.

THE VISION: FREEDOM THAT FORMS

We are pursuing freedom with intention. Not because debt is sinful, but because freedom is strategic. Throughout Scripture, freedom is never an end in itself; it is the condition that makes faithful obedience possible. When burdens are lifted, movement increases. When weight is removed, formation accelerates.

“The borrower is servant to the lender.”

— *Proverbs 22:7*

This proverb is not a moral indictment but a wisdom observation. Obligation shapes capacity. Constraints slow responsiveness. And while God works powerfully in every circumstance, Scripture consistently affirms that freedom creates space for faithfulness to flourish.

A mortgage-free house moves faster and farther in forming people to encounter God, experience transformation, and elevate lives. Freedom removes friction. Formation gains speed. Ministry becomes more agile. Vision becomes more scalable. Not about arrival, but about readiness for what God is forming next.

THE WAY: SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

God often accomplishes great things through simple obedience. Rarely does Scripture describe God moving through a few heroic individuals alone. More often, He moves through a people who choose to carry responsibility together.

"Everyone whose heart was stirred and whose spirit was willing came and brought the Lord's offering."

— Exodus 35:21

The pathway before us is clear and attainable:

3,000 shares at \$2,000 each by New Year's Eve 2026. To be a mortgage-free house.

This vision is not built on pressure or comparison. It is built on participation. **Equal sacrifice, equal ownership.** Each household prayerfully discerning how to take part in a shared journey.

When responsibility is shared, momentum multiplies.
When the house moves together, the mission moves forward.

THE PATHWAYS

Because faithfulness looks different in different seasons, this journey includes multiple pathways for participation. Some will give all at once. Others will give steadily over time. Some will save intentionally, day by day.

- One-time gifts.
- Monthly giving.
- Biweekly giving.
- Weekly giving.
- Daily set-aside practices.

Different rhythms. One mission.

These pathways honor the truth that generosity is not a moment but a practice. Faithfulness over time shapes capacity, deepens trust, and forms a people who know how to steward both little and much.

THE MORE-THAN-ONE

In every community, God entrusts some with the capacity to carry more not for distinction, but for service.

Some will carry one share.

Some will carry several.

"To whom much is given, much will be required."

– Luke 12:48

Every \$2,000 gift represents one share toward the 3,000 needed. For those who are able to give beyond one share, your generosity accelerates the journey for the entire house. This is not expectation; it is opportunity. Not obligation, but calling.

When some give more, everyone moves faster.

And the mission advances sooner.

FAITHFUL IN THE DOING MOVING TOWARD THE DONE

This journey is not about replacing what God has already established in our house, but about strengthening it. **3-2 & DONE** is an intentional commitment that **flows alongside our regular tithes and offerings, not instead of them.**

Faithfulness is not proven only in what we begin, but in what we sustain. We believe God is calling us to be **steady in the doing while trusting Him for the completion.** This season asks us to remain consistent, generous, and aligned - day by day, month by month - until the work is finished.

Scripture reminds us that when **God's people move together in faithfulness**, completion often comes sooner than expected. Like Nehemiah's wall - finished in a fraction of the time anyone imagined - **God has a way of accelerating what is aligned with His purposes.**

As we continue to worship, give, serve, and steward well, we trust that God will bring the work to completion, sometimes faster than we think, always in ways that reveal His faithfulness.
